Onxwines.com They worked with Kevin, "who was great. Very knowledgeable and great personality. And the wine was terrific." Two day shipping at \$25.00 per.

Hoytfamilyvineyards.com Shipping costs were much higher so all were shipped to one person for distribution. Wendy "did not think winemaker was as knowledgeable, but she was fine."

Mcvwines.com Also quite knowledgeable and receptive to questions.

We are still hoping to reschedule the National tasting!
